

INDICTMENT

FOR: WITNESS INTIMIDATION, 21 O.S. § 455 [3 counts]

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

On August 19, 2003, by order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma entered on the 3rd day of July, 2003, the ninth Oklahoma Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from that date until February 20, 2005, said term of the Multicounty Grand Jury beginning on August 19, 2003, and continuing thereafter, that the said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and women, legally drawn and summoned according to law and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn and charged according to law to diligently inquire into and true presentment make of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find that:

COUNT 1:

On or about the 16th day of March, 2004, A.D., and within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **GENEVA FAYE WORTHEN, a.k.a. GENEVA FAYE DeHART, a.k.a. FAYE WORTHEN, a.k.a. FAYE DeHART**, did commit the crime of **Witness Intimidation**. That is to say that within the county and state aforesaid the said defendant was under investigation by the Multicounty Grand Jury of Oklahoma. That is to say that then and there Steve Paris was a witness to said investigation by the Multicounty Grand Jury of Oklahoma. That then and there said defendant did willfully, unlawfully and feloniously cause mental harm through fear to said witness Paris, by causing a lawsuit for money damages, to-wit: Geneva Faye Worthen v. Sharron DeVault et al., Oklahoma County Case No. CJ-2004-2210, to be served upon said witness immediately prior to a scheduled date upon which said witness was known to be scheduled to testify before said Multicounty Grand Jury of Oklahoma, with the intent to prevent the witness from appearing in court to testify or to make said witness alter his testimony, contrary to the provisions of Section 455 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 2:

On or about the 16th day of March, 2004, A.D., and within the County of Oklahoma, State of Oklahoma, the defendant, **GENEVA FAYE WORTHEN, a.k.a. GENEVA FAYE DeHART, a.k.a. FAYE WORTHEN, a.k.a. FAYE DeHART**, did commit the crime of **Witness Intimidation**. That is to say that within the county and state aforesaid the said defendant was under investigation by the Multicounty Grand Jury of Oklahoma. That is to say that then and there Paulette Shafer was a witness to said investigation by the Multicounty Grand Jury of Oklahoma. That then and there said defendant did willfully, unlawfully and feloniously cause mental harm through fear to said witness Shafer, by causing a lawsuit for money damages, to-wit: Geneva Faye Worthen v. Sharron


DeVault et al., Oklahoma County Case No. CJ-2004-2210, to be served upon said witness immediately prior to a scheduled date upon which said witness was known to be scheduled to testify before said Multicounty Grand Jury of Oklahoma, with the intent to prevent the witness from appearing in court to testify or to make said witness alter her testimony, contrary to the provisions of Section 455 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Sharron DeVault et al., Oklahoma County Case No. CJ-2004-2210, to be served upon said witness immediately prior to a scheduled date upon which said witness was known to be scheduled to testify before said Multicounty Grand Jury of Oklahoma, with the intent to prevent the witness from appearing in court to testify or to make said witness alter her testimony, contrary to the provisions of Section 455 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma. WITNESS INTIMIDATION, 21 O.S. § 455, [each count]: not less than one (1) nor more than ten (10) years imprisonment in the State Penitentiary and a fine not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), see 21 O.S. § 64
