INDICTMENT

FOR: BRIBERY, 21 O.S. 2012, § 381

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Thirteenth Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from February 22, 2011 until August 22, 2012 or until the designated presiding judge determines the Thirteenth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That the said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and woman, legally drawn and summons according to law and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn and charged according to law to diligently inquire into and true presentment make of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find that:

COUNT 1: BRIBERY

On or about the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2012, A.D., the crime of Bribery was committed in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, by the defendant, TINA THI VO. That is to say that on or about

said date and within said County and State, Patricia Migialaccio was employed as an Investigator for the Cosmetology Board, an agency of the State of Oklahoma. That is to further state that on or about said date, Tina Vo was a person seeking an Instructor's license from the Oklahoma Cosmetology Board. That on or about the said date and within said County and State, the defendant did willfully, intentionally, corruptly, and feloniously promise to pay Migialaccio, whom she knew was an Investigator for the Cosmetology Board, Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) for Migialaccio to arrange for Vo, who is Asian and not perfectly fluent in reading the English language, to be given an oral examination for an Instructor's license to be issued by the Cosmetology Board and to assure that Vo passed by providing the correct answers to Vo by hand or finger signals in the course of the applicant taking the test. All of the foregoing being committed in violation of Section 381 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.


